Missouri stands to receive more than \$40 million from the Volkswagen Environmental Mitigation Trust. This Trust will support projects that reduce NOx emissions in areas where VW diesel vehicles were, or are currently, operated. Each state will determine the final plan for how the funds will be utilized.
